



Intermittent Catheterization (IC)

MICTURITION CHART

Information

A micturition chart is a tool to adjust how often you need to catheterize. You need to record both during the day and night, for 48 hours/2 days.

Note when and how much fluid you drink and urinate before you catheterize and the catheterized volume (ml). Normal voiding volume is 200-400 ml, the amount of urine shouldn't exceed 400 ml, both catheterized and voided volume.

Write a description of how the sensation of your bladder felt when you went to the toilet using the numbers as codes:

- 1= No sensation of needing to pass urine, for example, passed urine just before going out
- 2= Normal sensation to pass urine and no urgency
- 3= Urgent sensation, I need to go immediately to the toilet

If you leak urine, show this by writing an 'X' on the diary at the time you leaked.
